

Guidance for Filling Out a Crossing / Proximity Information Form

November 2019

The form is applicable and requires completion in the following instances:

- construct a facility across, on, under or along NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)
- operate a vehicle or mobile equipment across NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)
- temporarily or permanently installing on NOVA Chemicals' right-of-way a pathway or other facility / structure

Each request is different. All section(s) related to the request must be completed.

For example, a request submitted for a pipeline to be built across NOVA Chemicals pipeline(s) would require the completion of the following sections:

- Section 1: Introduction
- Section 2: Pipeline across, on along or under NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)
- Section 7: Heavy Equipment Crossing (e.g. construction vehicles)

More examples:

Activity	Sections to Complete
Pipeline across, on or along NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)	1, 2 & 7
Cable line(s) across, on, along or under NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)	1, 3 & 7
Overhead power line(s) across, on or along NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)	1, 4 & 7
Permanent road, rail or path across, on or along NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)	1, 5 & 7
Permanent structure other than listed above (ex. fence, piperack, swale, etc.)	1, 6 & 7
Temporary heavy equipment access across, on or along NOVA Chemicals' pipeline(s)	1 & 7

Complex applications

For complex applications, such as railway crossings, NOVA Chemicals will engage directly with the applicant to ensure the appropriate information is requested and shared among our internal subject matter experts.

In any situation, NOVA Chemicals may request additional information to complete an assessment.

NOTE: NOVA Chemicals also operates CER-regulated pipelines on behalf of Genesis Pipeline Canada Ltd. in Ontario.
