## **Construction Progress at Rokeby Site**

As summer rolls on, so does construction at the future Rokeby Site! Over 550 tradespeople are onsite daily to progress foundations, erect steel and pave roadways. Construction on the site's future multipurpose and administration building began this month, and heavy and oversized equipment are beginning to arrive.

We shared with you in the July issue of this newsletter that construction worker traffic is transitioning to the Rokeby Site main entrance at 804 Rokeby Line. We anticipate this to begin in early September.

In keeping with our on-site traffic management plan, vehicles leaving the construction site have been instructed to travel west on Rokeby Line for access to Highway 40.



Rebar and foundation work continues in the Utilities area.

## **Construction Activity on Gate #3 Roadway**

As part of the Corunna Cracker Expansion Project, 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Gate #3 roadway) is being widened to accommodate the arrival of the new heaters to Corunna Site.

Work is scheduled over the afternoon shift, beginning at 4:00 pm and is anticipated to last four weeks. Neighbours may see temporary construction lighting and roadwork crews during this time.

An on-site traffic management plan is in place to mitigate traffic impacts. Traffic management plans are continuously monitored should control measures need to be implemented to enhance safety and reduce risk.

This newsletter is intended to share information on construction of our new Rokeby Site.

The project involves the construction of a second Advanced SCLAIRTECH™ technology facility (AST2) to be located at the new Rokeby Site, adjacent to our Corunna Site.

With a capacity of approximately one billion pounds of polyethylene per year, the facility will allow us to continue to grow our polyethylene business in high performance applications and will provide greater supply reliability for our customers. Construction is underway with start-up targeted for late 2021.

This project is part of a capital investment of approximately \$2 billion for two new significant projects for our St. Clair Township operations: the new polyethylene facility and the next phase in the expansion of our Corunna Site cracker.

Construction is underway and detailed engineering work continues, with approximately 550 local tradespeople currently onsite.
