The facility is located approximately 21 miles south of Baton Rouge and 60 miles west of New Orleans, within the Iberville and Ascension Parishes.

## PRODUCTION



Geismar produces approximately 2 billion pounds of ethylene and 50 million pounds of polymer grade propylene and coproducts annually.



Our team of 130 people are responsible for the safe operation of this jointly owned facility and delivery of olefin products by pipeline, barge, and rail.
